# **Application Procedures for Multiple-entry Visa for Nationals of India**

# <Temporary visitors for Tourism, Business affairs, Visiting relatives etc.>

\*Please DO NOT staple the documents together \*

#### A. Outline of application procedures

The following is an outline of application procedures for nationals of India who wish to apply for a multipleentry visa as a temporary visitor (period of stay: 90 days, visa validity: 5 years). The visa is for the purpose of tourism, business affairs, and visits to relatives/acquaintances, so it is not permitted to perform activities to undertake revenue generating business operations or activities to receive remuneration

#### B. Eligibility for Applicant with business purpose

Nationals of India with ordinary MRP (Machine Readable Passport) / e-passport in compliance with the ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) standard, who wishes to apply for a multiple entry visa and are applicable to one of the following categories:

- (a) Individual who has travel records as temporary visitor to Japan twice or more in the last three years
- (b) Individual who has travel record as temporary visitor to Japan in the last three years and has financial capacity to pay the travel expense
- (c) Individual who has travel record as temporary visitor to Japan and travel records as temporary visitor to G7 countries (except Japan) in the last three years
- (d) Individual with sufficient financial capacity
- (e) Spouse or children of the individuals who are mentioned (d) above

#### C. Necessary Documents

#### (a) Applicant

# ☐① Valid Passport

- at least one blank visa page
- \* We will keep passports while processing visa applications

## **□2** One visa application form

- completed and signed
- 'Certificate of Eligibility No.' field does not need to be filled in

## **□ 3** One passport-type photo

- photo(approx.45mm×35mm) taken with a plain background within the previous 6 months attached to the visa application form

## **□ 4 Valid Residence Permit in the Netherlands (VERBLIJFSTITEL)**

- Or a letter from the Dutch IND showing that the extension or application of your Residence Card is approved.

#### **□ 5 Letter of proxy**

- if other person applies for a visa instead of you

#### **□**6 Current or old passport

- that shows Japanese temporary visitor visa and entry stamp in the last three years (only in case B. (a), (b) or (c))

\*Some additional documents which certify incomes such as bank statement, stock dividend, pension,

- □ ④ Copy of a passport of the person mentioned B. (d) above
  - Pages of identification and Japanese multiple-entry visa
- □⑤ Letter of explanation stating the reason of applying for a multiple-entry visa

# <Temporary visitors for Business affairs>

## A. Outline of application procedures

The following is an outline of application procedures for nationals of India who wish to apply for a multiple-entry visa for business purpose, and (period of stay: 15, 30, or 90 days, visa validity: 1, 3, 5, 10 years).

The visa is for the purpose of business affairs for the first visit, but from the second visit it is possible to use as tourist or visiting to relatives/ acquaintances as well. But it is not permitted to perform activities to undertake revenue generating business operations or activities to receive remuneration.

#### B. Eligibility for Applicant with business purpose

Applicant who is applicable to one of the following categories and his/her spouse or children

- (a) A regular employee of a public (government) enterprise
- (b) An employee of a private company which is listed on the stock exchange (including Japan and third countries)
- (c) A regular employee of a Japanese-affiliated company which is a member of the Japan Chamber of Commerce and has a management base in Japan
- (d) A regular employee of a joint venture company, a subsidiary company or a branch office of a company which is listed on the stock exchange (including Japan and the third countries)
- (e) A regular employee of a private company with constant business transactions with a Japanese company which is listed on the stock exchange
- (f) A regular employee with a travel record to Japan for business purpose and travel records as temporary visitor to G7 countries (except Japan) in the last three years
- (g) A regular employee with more than three travel records to Japan for business purpose in the last three year

#### C. Necessary Documents

- at least one blank visa page
- **□2** One <u>visa application form</u>
  - completed and signed
  - 'Certificate of Eligibility No.' field does not need to be filled in

# **□ 3** One passport-type photo

- photo(approx.45mm×35mm) taken with a plain background within the previous 6 months attached to the visa application form
- □ ④ Valid Residence Permit in the Netherlands (VERBLIJFSTITEL)
  - Or a letter from the Dutch IND showing that the extension or application of your Residence Card is approved.

# **□ S Letter of proxy**

- if other person applies for a visa instead of you

- \* If necessary, we might ask for additional documents apart from the documents mentioned above.
- \* Please note that we may issue a single entry visa after visa examination.
