Multiple-entry visas may be issued to applicants with a substantially high income or a sufficient level of financial
capability and their families. Visas for the applicants with a substantially high income are valid for 5 years and the
period of stay allowed for each visit is up to 90 days, and visas for the applicants with a sufficient level of financial
capability are valid for 3 years and the period of stay allowed for each visit is up to 30 days.

- (a) A regular employee of a public (government) enterprise
- (b) An employee of a private company which is listed on the stock exchange (including Japan and third countries)
- (c) A regular employee of a Japanese-affiliated company which is a member of the Japan Chamber of Commerce and has a management base in Japan
- (d) A regular employee of a joint venture company, a subsidiary company or a branch office of a company which is listed on the stock exchange (including Japan and the third countries)
- (e) A regular employee of a private company with constant business transactions with a Japanese company which is listed on the stock exchange
- (f) A regular employee with more than three travel records to Japan for business purpose in the last one year
- (g) A regular employee with more than ten travel records to Japan for business purpose in the last three years
