## <u>Application Procedures for Multiple-entry Visa for Nationals of</u>

# Indonesia, the Philippines and Viet Nam

### <Temporary visitors for Tourism, Business affairs, Visiting relatives etc.>

\*Please DO NOT staple the documents together\*

#### A. Outline of application procedures

The following is an outline of application procedures for nationals of Indonesia, the Philippines, and Viet Nam who wish to apply for a Multiple-entry Visa as a temporary visitor.

The visa is for the purpose of tourism, business affairs, and visits to relatives/ acquaintances, so it is not permitted to perform activities to undertake revenue generating business operations or activities to receive remuneration.

#### B. Eligibility for Applicant

Nationals of Indonesia, the Philippines, and Viet Nam with ordinary MRP (Machine Readable Passport) / e-passport in compliance with the ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) standard, who wishes to apply for a Multiple-entry Visa for a stay of up to 30 days and are applicable to one of the following categories:

- (a) Individual who has travel record as temporary visitor to Japan in the last three years and who has ability to pay the travel expense
- (b) Individual who has a travel record as temporary visitor to Japan and travel records as temporary visitor to G7 countries (except Japan) in the last three years
- (c) Individual with sufficient financial capacity
- (d) Spouse or children of the individuals who are mentioned (c) above

#### C. Necessary Documents

#### (a) Applicant who are mentioned B. (a), (b) or (c) above

- □① **Valid Passport** (MRP / e-passport in compliance with the ICAO standard only)
  - at least one blank visa page
  - \* We will keep passports while processing visa applications
- **□2** One visa application form
  - completed and signed
  - 'Certificate of Eligibility No.' field does not need to be filled in

#### **□ 3** One passport-type photo

- photo(approx.45mm×35mm) taken with a plain background within the previous 6 months attached to the visa application form
- **□ 4 Valid Residence Permit in the Netherlands (VERBLIJFSTITEL)** 
  - Or a letter from the Dutch IND showing that the extension or application of your Residence Card is approved.

#### **□ 5 Letter of proxy**

- if other person applies for a visa instead of you
